

Sign PDF documents with digital signatures




Traditionally, forms and other documents that required signatures had to be printed, signed in ink, and then scanned, uploaded, and submitted. FineReader PDF streamlines the process by enabling

you to securely sign digital documents directly.

A digital signature is a digital equivalent of a wet-ink signature on paper documents. Technically, a digital signature is a message that the signer encrypts using a private key for their digital certificate, which associates itself with both the document and the signer. This message is added to the document and can be decrypted by anyone with a matching public key for verification. FineReader PDF lets you create and add a digital signature to any PDF with just a few clicks.












Copy and paste entire tables

ABBYY FineReader PDF offers a series of AI-guided tools for correcting and enhancing page images, allowing you to adjust page orientation, skews, distorted text lines, and jagged characters.
